

**DRUG-ENDANGERED CHILDREN
RISK ASSESSMENT**

The presence of any of the following factors detracts from the safety, security and well-being of children. *Please answer the following questions with as much detail as possible.*

I. PROOF of OCCUPANCY

1. Does the child or children live in the residence? Show proof of bedroom, clothing, toys, food, etc.?

2. Does the child or children visit the residence? No proof of residency but proof of temporary occupancy (ie. toys, play area etc.)?

II. TYPE OF DRUG RELATED OFFENCE

Cultivation

1. Has the child been exposed to an indoor cannabis grow?

2. Are there hazards such as exposed wires, electrical cables or over loaded circuitry within access of the child? Please list items present.

3. Has the child been or is at risk of poisoning from CO₂, carbon monoxide, black mold, herbicides or pesticides used indoors, or burning solvents such as ether or acetone etc?

Drug Manufacturing

1. Were drugs being manufactured or stored in the residence? Did the child live in or have access to this location? (ie. methamphetamine lab, crack cocaine lab)

2. Are there chemicals or substances present in the residence which are intended for the illegal manufacturing of a drug? Please list items present.

3. Are these chemicals or substances within access of the child? Please describe storage methods and where being stored at the residence? (note height of storage in relation to the child's height)

4. Did the child ingest, inhale, or be exposed in any other manner with a chemical or substance used to illegally manufacture drugs? Please list.

5. Has the child been at risk or is at risk of poisoning or burns from burning solvents such as ether or acetone etc?

Trafficking

1. Has the child been exposed to drug trafficking?
2. Are drugs being stored within access of the child? Please describe storage methods and where being stored at the residence? (note height of storage in relation to the child's height)
3. Has the child been exposed or is at risk to being physically injured from weapons such as firearms, knives, booby traps, dangerous guard animals etc. in the residence?
4. Has the child been exposed or is at risk to being physically injured from drug paraphernalia such as syringes, crack or methamphetamine pipes in the residence?

III. Guardian Using Illicit Drug

1. Are there indications that the guardian is using illicit drugs?

2. Has the child been exposed to second hand smoke?

IV. General Neglect / Maltreatment

1. Has the child been or is at risk to being emotionally injured or sexually abused because of guardian exposing child to other forms of illegal activity?

2. Has the child's basic needs of shelter, food and clothing been met?

3. Is the child living in sanitary conditions with heat, electricity, running water, refrigeration and basic hygiene needs being met?
